POLICY CIRCULAR (Revised)

SUB: Targeting for Best Results.

REF: Our Earlier Circular No. SVIT/1289/2021-22 dated 19/11/2023.

This is in continuation to our earlier Circular referred to above.

- (a) Best Teachers are to be allotted for difficult/tough subjects which will have more failures and generally dents the performance of the semester results.
- (b) Not to allow fresh teachers who have not handled the difficult/tough subjects, on experimental basis.
- (c) Concrete plan/strategy for thoroughly preparing students in difficult subjects targeting best results in the subject is to be submitted at the beginning of every semester.
- (d) Constant monitoring of academics by HODs and ensuring coverage of syllabus by every faculty in department as per the plan (2.0 modules before first test 1.5 modules before 2nd test and 1.5 modules before 3rd test).
- (e) Difficult subjects shall be closely monitored by HODs personally.
- (f) Submitting result analysis within A WEEK from the day of the result announcement.
- (g) **Targets to be Achieved as follows:**

g-1 – for BE Program

- i. 1st Year results minimum 80% and above.
- ii. 2nd Year results minimum of 82 % and above.
- iii. 3rd year results minimum of 85 % and above.
- iv. **4th Year – ie., for both**
- v. 7th Semester results minimum 98% and above.
- vi. 8th semester results shall be targeted for 100% for the academic year 2023-24.

g-2 – for MBA Program

- i. 1st Year Results minimum of 80% & above.
- ii. 2nd Year Results minimum of 90% & above.

HODs shall observe and record the performance. The Parents shall be informed from time to time about the unsatisfactory performance of their wards.

All the HODs shall strictly monitor the academics and ensure the best result for the academic year 2023-24.
