MINUTES OF THE 13TH GOVERNING COUNCIL MEETING

HELD ON 21/12/2019 AT 11-30 AM AT PRINCIPAL'S CHAMBER

Director, Prof. M R Holla welcomed all the members present in the meeting. He said that before going into the Agenda, Principal would give a Power Point Presentation of the progress made during the period starting from May 2019 till date.

Principal, having welcomed the Chairman, Members and the Special Invitees present gave a brief report of the progress made hitherto and the same is enclosed herewith for reference.

SUBJECT-1 To read and ratify the Proceedings of the previous meeting held on 27th April 2019.

Resolution: The Proceedings of the previous meeting has been read over and the same has been taken on record after ratification by the members.

SUBJECT-2 Welcome and Brief Report by the Principal about the progress of the Institution during the academic year 2019-20 (Even Semester 2018-19 and Odd Semester 2019-20).

Resolution: The Report about the progress of the Institution has been given by the Principal through PPT presentation as said above. The Report has been unanimously approved by the members.

SUBJECT-3 Report on the performance of the students in the VTU exams - Even Semester 2018-19.

On the results of Mechanical Engineering, it is commented that the results are not up to the mark. For this, Principal said that because of some tough subjects the students are failing. Coming to the performance of the students in the last EVEN Semester, for low results in some branches, Principal said that atleast 15% of the students do not attend to the classes and it seems that they are admitted by their parents although the students are not interested. Principal said that the Proctors are doing a good job.

Principal also explained that this time **SVAS** has been introduced. Principal said that because of SVAS whenever a student absents even for a single period immediately within 30 minutes after that period the parents get the message about his/her absence.

Resolution: The members appreciated the efforts put by the Principal in seeing that the students attend to their classes regularly - the basic need of a student to attend to classes regularly - and felt that the results in certain areas where the results are not up to expectation are to be improved adopting suitable strategies.

SUBJECT-4 Ratification of the appointments of Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff made from 1/4/2019 till 30/11/2019.

For a query from Mr Rajashekar Reddy as to why 15 faculty members have left in a short span of time, Principal said that some of them have left for better prospects and some have scored less in the 'Evaluation by the students' and hence relieved.

Resolution: The appointments during the period from 1/4/2019 till 30/11/2019 have been discussed and approved after clarification from the Principal.

SUBJECT-5 Ratification of purchases made for the laboratories and construction from 1/4/2019 till 30/11/2019.

Resolution: After discussions, the Members have unanimously approved the purchases made for the laboratories and construction, from 1/4/2019 till 30/11/2019.

SUBJECT-6 Report on Placement and Training Activities during Odd Semester 2019-2020.

Resolution: The matter provided in the Reports has been discussed and the Report has been approved unanimously.

Mr Lokesh K V suggested that there are good chances for appointment in Amazon and the students can be advised/referred to for the placement in Amazon.

SUBJECT-7 Report of the achievements in sports, cultural and co-curricular activities during the ODD semester of the academic year 2019-20.

Resolution: After discussion about the achievements in sports, cultural and co-curricular activities that took place during ODD semester 2019-20, the members have formally approved the report.

SUBJECT-8 Approval for the increase in in-take for the following courses and to start two new BE Courses after NBA Accreditation from the Academic Year 2020-21, as follows:

Mr Srinivas Raju said not to close the department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering or any branch.

As regards to admissions following discussions held in general:

Mr Lokesh suggested to give scholarship to the deserving candidates in order to improve the admissions. Principal substantiated this idea and said that this will help in filling up the Management quota seats.

Principal also reiterated the need for branding our Institution and see that it reaches every nook and corner of the state and also North India so that it helps in increase in admissions.

Mr Srinivas Raju gave statistics that only 15 % of the parents can afford for Engineering qualification in India to-day. The down-trend of economy, weak purchasing power of money due to various policies of the Government the parents are not coming forward to admit their children to the professional colleges. It is a sheer marketing strategy to lure the prospective students and parents to our college irrespective of the good quality of education we offer to the students.

Mr Lokesh K V said that in this scenario it is necessary to evolve some strategy for bigger market. Based on break-even point we have to work out for new strategies, he said.

Mr Srinivas Raju said that it is better to conduct meeting of the parents of the PUC Students of the nearby colleges so that they will be happy to admit their children to this Institution in case they intend admitting their children to an Engineering College. This point has been noted for adoption in due course of time.

SUBJECT-9 - Ratification of Service Rules of SVIT.

Coming to the Ratification of Service Rules of SVIT, Mr Rajashekara Reddy suggested that after clause No.48 one more clause is to be included as follows:

"Any Rules promulgated by Government under Karnataka Educational Act 1983 and any order including the notifications issued by the Government from time to time relatable to educational institutions shall mutatis and mutandis applicable."

Also at DIFINITIONs, at point 'c' instead of "Appointing Authority" started with, "Trust Authorized" to be started with.

Resolution: With the above changes the 'SVIT Service Rules' have been approved by the members to bring the same into existence for implementation.

ANY OTHER ISSUES (AOS):

- AOS 1 Principal also said that the Institution is applying for the recognition of Research Centers by VTU for the departments of -
 - (a) Department of Information Science and Engineering
 - (b) Department of Physics
 - (c) Department MBA

so that all the departments will be having Research Centers except the Department of Chemistry.

Resolution: The members have approved for having Research Centers in all the above said three departments.

Mr R Srinivas Raju suggested to Prof. R C Shanmukha Swamy to go for 'Solar Power Generators'. Principal said that AICTE is encouraging for 'go-green' activities such as Solar Power Generators, Rainwater Harvesting, Solid Waste Management, etc.

Resolution: Prof. R C Shanmukha Swamy said that the same can be decided in the next Board Meeting.

AOS - 3 Prof. M R Holla, Chairman, Governing Council enquired about the 'Rain Water Harvesting Project' Progress with Prof. R C Shanmukha Swamy, Dean (Administration).

Resolution: Prof. R C Shanmukha Swamy informed the house that the arrangements for the water collection at ground level is done and need to be diverted to a Sump and it will be taken up at the earliest.

Mr Manohar M K said that lot of funds available under (Corporate Social Responsibility) CSR Schemes. Lot of companies are coming forward for utilizing such funds. Even Educational Institutions are coming under this category.

For this, Mr Lokesh K V said that unless we fulfill some social service responsibilities the same cannot be utilized.

Principal thanked all the members for their valuable suggestions and advices.
