Principal also narrated the following to the Governing Council Members:

- MOUs have been entered into with outside agencies on various activities in the areas of student learning, R&D, Innovation, etc.
- SVAS (Sai Vidya Automation System) a Student Management Software has been introduced for quick and accurate data feeding, accessibility obtaining data with different calibration of requirement and such other usefulness.
- 'SAVI', You Tube Channel where the lectures of difficult subjects and the processes of all the laboratories are video recorded and uploaded for rumination by the students at the time of the examinations of respective subjects.
- > Sri Srinivas Raju also appreciated the introduction of SAVI.
- Presentation of papers by our students at many foreign countries received lot of appreciation because at most of the places the papers were presented mostly by the Research Scholars and those who are pursuing PhDs.
- Some foreign nationals from France are doing Internship under the guidance Dr Narayan C.
- In the recent **Sammilana** about 280 old students were participated.
- Under NSS the students are participating in various social Activities to imbibe social culture and thus shouldering social responsibilities:
- College is putting efforts to have an NCC centre in order to inculcate discipline in the students. Having a college NCC unit is also a prestige question and adds to the value of the college.

A workshop has been arranged for the Mechanical Engineering to become conversant in English Communication with the help of Prof. Sujatha Mukherjee. It is reported that the students have not only showed the interest but they really put efforts to improve themselves in written and spoken English Communications.

Resolution: The Report about the progress of the Institution, aged just 11 years, is in fact lauded by the members present and approved.

Principal said that in the higher semesters the students are doing well since the non-performers get filtered in the lower semesters.

Resolution: Different strategies are to be explored for improving the results in the coming years.

When the members expressed that so many personnel have been appointed, Principal said that they include all categories and an equal amount of personnel have been separated rather relieved based on their performance during previous period. Principal also pointed out that in fact the strength of non-teaching staff is below the requirement of VTU.

AOS - 1 Sri Srinivasa Raju was particular about acquiring NBA Accreditation. He insisted rather to go for NBA Accreditation by September 2019 itself so that by December 2019 inspection will be over and by March 2020 NBA Accreditation can be obtained. The Chairman said that it is necessary to enhance the sanctioned strength thereafter in the following order.

ECE - to 180 ISE - to 120 CSE - to 120

Resolution: It has been unanimously decided to go for NBA Accreditation by the end of 2019 and subsequently for the increase in the sanctioned strength.

- AOS -2 For a question from the Chairman about the NPTEL registrations, Principal said that about 2400 students and teachers have registered and among them 170 students and teachers have applied for certification.
- AOS 3 Chairman observed that many things which have presented by the Principal through Power Point Presentation do not find place in the regular Agenda. Therefore, he suggested from next time to include everything as a part of Agenda and with the help of Power Point Presentation the Meeting can be completed in short duration.
- AOS 4 Chairman also highlighted that many GC members are absent and hence opined that it is necessary to write to them about the importance of their presence in the GC Meeting to pool their ideas for the overall improvement of the Institution.
- AOS 2 Chairman appreciated the Principal for a neat and comprehensive presentation of the report encompassing all the areas of institutional curricular and non-curricular activities.


