

In the personality assessment, Dr Pradeep N E conducted a live psychometric assessment of students using MBTI tool by which students were able to learn on their own personality traits. Further it was deliberated to make them aware about matching personality traits with their career goals.

In the competency assessment, SOCI tool was used to analyze student's individual Strengths, Opportunities, Challenges and Improvement Areas on the identified parameters that included Attitude, Skills, Knowledge & Interest.

At the outset, students were able to learn on their individual personality traits and the competencies to plan and pursue their career path responsibly.
